

Subject: Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Notice, Leatherhead Road, Oxshott

Dear all,

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Leatherhead Road (A244) Oxshott as extends for a distance of 100 metres either side of its junction with Danes Hill School Drive. This Order shall come into operation on 17 July 2018 for a period of twelve months. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. This Order is required to enable major carriageway and/or footway maintenance to be carried out on behalf of Surrey County Council within the length described in this Notice. Works are anticipated to be carried out over nights within one week of the temporary Order. Access through the closure is to be maintained for pedestrians, dismounted cyclists and emergency services at all times. Access to residential premises within the length of the closure will be maintained under direction of a banksman. All other vehicular traffic and HGVs will be diverted via Leatherhead Road, Kingston Road, Fair Oak Lane and Leatherhead Road or this route in reverse order. In the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time, under Section 3 of the Act, the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24 hour period. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
