

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL - KNIPP HILL (D6855) AND LITTLEHEATH LANE (D6855), COBHAM -  
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2018

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of:

- a) Knipp Hill (D6855), Cobham that extends from its junction with Littleheath Lane (D6855), to its junction with Pony Chase (D6855); vehicular traffic will be diverted via Water Lane, Fairmile Lane, Miles Lane and Knipp Hill; and
- b) Littleheath Lane (D6855), Cobham that extends from its junction with Knipp Hill (D6855), to the north-eastern property boundary of "Pinewood"; vehicular traffic will be diverted via Water Lane, Fairmile Lane, Stoke Road and Blundel Lane.

The Temporary Order is required to enable water mains replacement works on behalf of SES Water. These works are anticipated to be carried out in phases, between the hours of 07:30 and 17:30 within seven months of the twelve-month period of operation of the Order, which commences on 14 January 2019. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated will be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians, cyclists, equestrians, residents, businesses and emergency services will be maintained at all times.
